The Eisenhower Tunnel on I-70 is one of the longest vehicular tunnels in the United States. Named after President Eisenhower, who inspired the creation of the interstate system,

the Eisenhower Tunnel is also one of the highest-elevation tunnels in the world. It has a maximum elevation of 11,158 feet and connects Colorado's eastern and western halves.
