Today's Presenters: GH Phipps

This week's presentation featured Kent Cohen, Christina Enloe, Brent Chacon, and Kaitlyn Emery from GH Phipps. They discussed their work on the Beck Venture Center and the Parking Garage next to the Venture Center on campus. Below are some notes about what was shared:

- The Venture Center costs \$21.5 million and is 31,230 square feet.
- There are 24 geothermal Wells drilled 600' into the ground, and the building runs solely on geothermal wells and electricity.
- C+PK II is a \$69 million parking garage and classroom with 800 parking spaces, and one of the classrooms will have the largest lecture hall on campus with 315 seats.
- Both projects are Gold LEED certified, a Colorado requirement for all new buildings.
