#### **Today's Presenters: WSP**

This week's presentation featured Melanie Monarco and Isaac Anthony from WSP. Melanie discussed her experience with the Transit and Rail Industry, and Issac discussed his work on the Central I-70 section through Denver. Below are some notes about what was shared:

- The transit and rail industry has national guidance, not standards, and the railroad company chooses the specifications.
- 4'- 8.5" is the standard rail gauge in the United States, which was created from wagon wheel tracks, which were the precursor to modern train tracks.
- Melanie worked on part of the RTD transit network, installing a new station along with the LA Metro Expedition expansion, which required her to fit two light rail tracks through a tunnel designed for a single freight track.
- The I-70 lowering included 15 vehicle bridges, 3 rail bridges, and a four-acre cover on top of the newly lowered interstate.
