



## Colorado School of Mines 42<sup>nd</sup> Intercollegiate Mining Games Sponsorship Information 2019-2020 Season



### Competition Expenses:

The Colorado School of Mines Mining Competition Team is proud to announce that we will be hosting the 42<sup>nd</sup> Intercollegiate Mining Games in March of 2020!

This means that we are in need of funding to put on a terrific event for all of those in attendance. As a team we are responsible for lodging accommodations for attendants, the competition grounds, the competition tools and materials, food for competitors, coaches and volunteers, social events, transportation for competitors to competition grounds from lodging, safety expenses associated with event, and all other aspects of the games.

As we begin planning for the games, the volume of funding needing to put on a memorable experience is becoming apparent. As the hosts of the game, we aim to create an event that is more than just mining games for those who participate. We are setting out to create a contest that provides a competitive atmosphere that also brings teams from around the world together. We also aim to connect mining companies and mining students through the sponsorships that help fund the games as well as the involvement of volunteers in the industry. The sponsorship packages on page 3 break down the available levels of support, as well as the budget on page 2 which highlights the expenses of the games by category.

### Team Expenses:

The Colorado School of Mines Mining Competition Team has been practicing on the same equipment for the last 4 years. The equipment has treated us excellently, allowing us to place well in the last 3 Intercollegiate Mining games. However, through the wear of 5 practices a week over the last 4 years our practice equipment is beginning to show signs of its age.

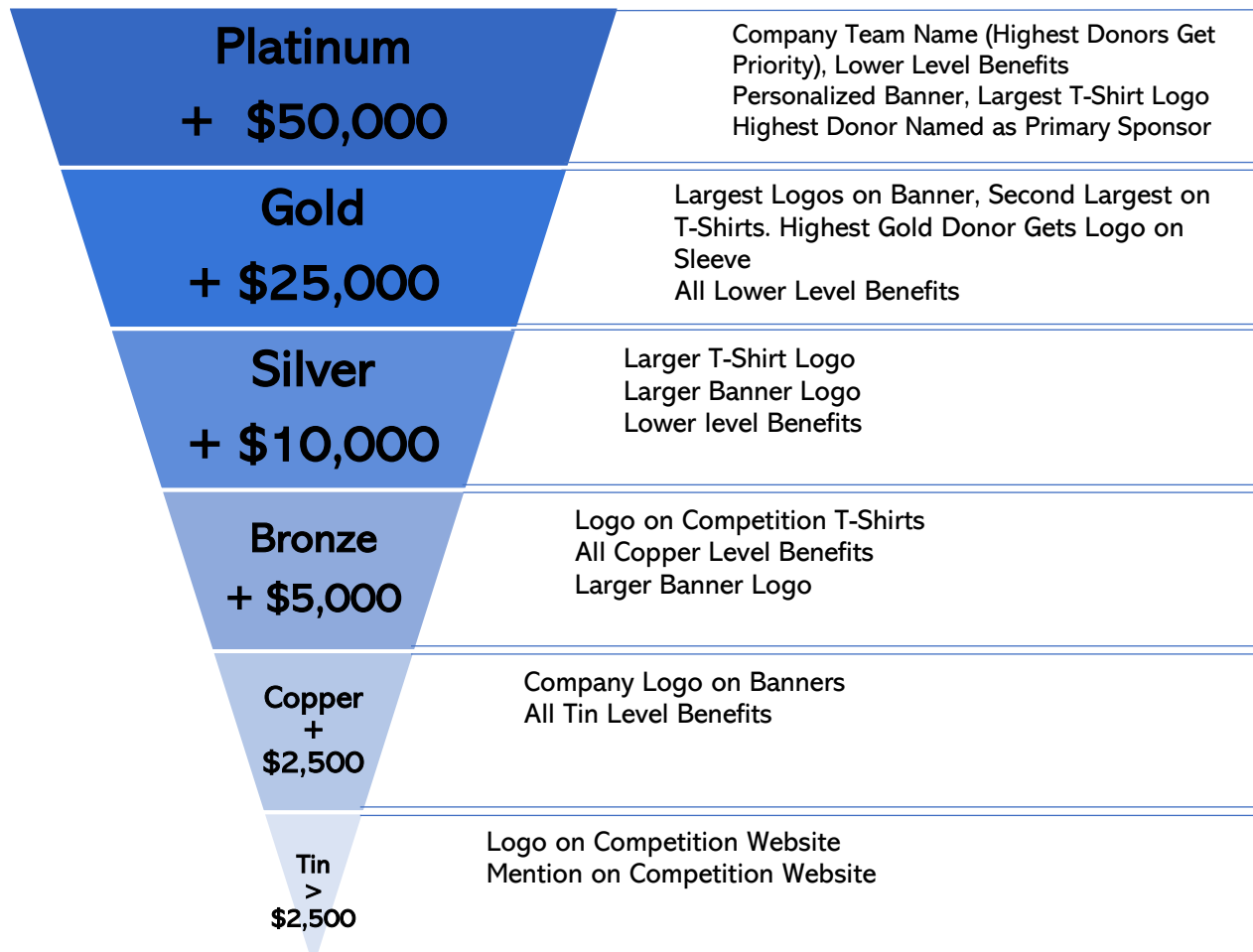
As we begin practicing for the 2020 games, we are also expecting an increase in participation. We are hoping to, at a minimum, double the number of teams we had during the 2019 competition. This would mean a total of 4 teams, each with 6 team members, all of who will be practicing 5 days a week in preparation for the 2020 games.

Due to the age of our equipment and the increase in participation we are in need of funding to allow effective and beneficial practices for the team. For the upcoming practice season our team is in need of a new set of hand steels, new jacklegging blocks, drill oil, swede saw (bow saw) blades, WD-40, PPE (hearing protection and eye protection), as well as miscellaneous items including spray-paint and markers.

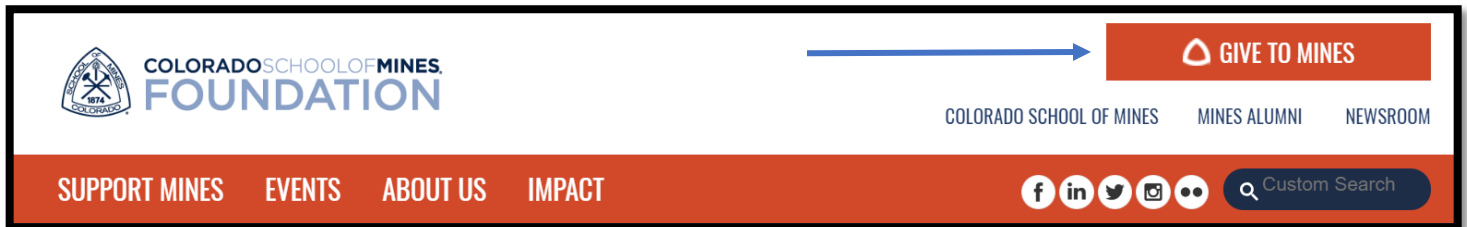
## How to Contribute
